

## Sign Plan for Randolph County Recycling Center

### Part 1-Entrance Signs

Place a sign at each entrance explaining items to be recycled and prohibited items. The signs will be white background reflective with 4" black "Arial Bold" font lettering. Column A- "We Recycle" accepted items and Column B "Prohibited Items"- (2 signs total)

- We recycle: Aluminum, Steel, White paper, Magazines, Corrugated cardboard, #1 Plastic (clear), #2 Plastic
- Prohibited items: Plastic Bags, Batteries, Light Bulbs, Lids to plastic items, Compressed cardboard, Phone books, hard bound books (take to local library), and Brown Bags. Glass and Yard Waste are prohibited here and must go to City facility at 31 Jones Drive.
- Statement below columns- RCSWA website on sign "for further information about where to recycle prohibited items"
- Statement on bottom of sign -"PLEASE- Do not leave anything here that is prohibited and not accepted"

### Part 2- Recycling Bin Signs

Have duplicate signs made to be able to clip onto wall and additionally on Gaylord boxes (recycling bins) that corresponds to the recycling bin. The signs will be white background non-reflective with 4" black "Arial Bold" font lettering.

- Aluminum Beverage Cans (4 signs)
- All other Aluminum (4 signs)
- Steel Cans (4 signs)
- Corrugated Cardboard-  
Please flatten/breakdown boxes (12 signs)
- #1 Clear Plastic  
w No Lids (8 Signs)
- #2 Plastic  
w No Lids (8 Signs)
- Newspaper Only (4 Signs)
- White Paper/ Magazines  
Office Paper –no phone books (8 Signs)
